The MTRCA has convened an Advisory Committee to advise on the plan of the Natural Areas of Tommy Thompson Park. This Committee is made up of one representative of each of the main user groups, MTRCA and MNR staff, and one non user - The Outer Harbour Sailing Federation. The Committee's first meeting was held on April 6 at the MTRCA headquarters. The MTRCA outlined the Advisory Committee's role - to provide advice only - and proceeded to discuss the items pertinent to the future use of the Natural Areas. F.O.S., and many other user groups present, stated that their presence [at the meeting] did not imply acceptance of Concept D; but indicated a desire to advise on the use, planning, and management of the Natural Area. The MTRCA has a great urge to see the Natural Area "finished" and developed (the size[!!!!] of the Interpretive Centre was their first item of discussion!!). The Committee shot this down, and spent a long time trying to formulate ideas re: principles and minimal levels of management needed. The next meeting is May 11th -- we'll keep you informed of progress. If you have any comments or suggestions, please send them in.
